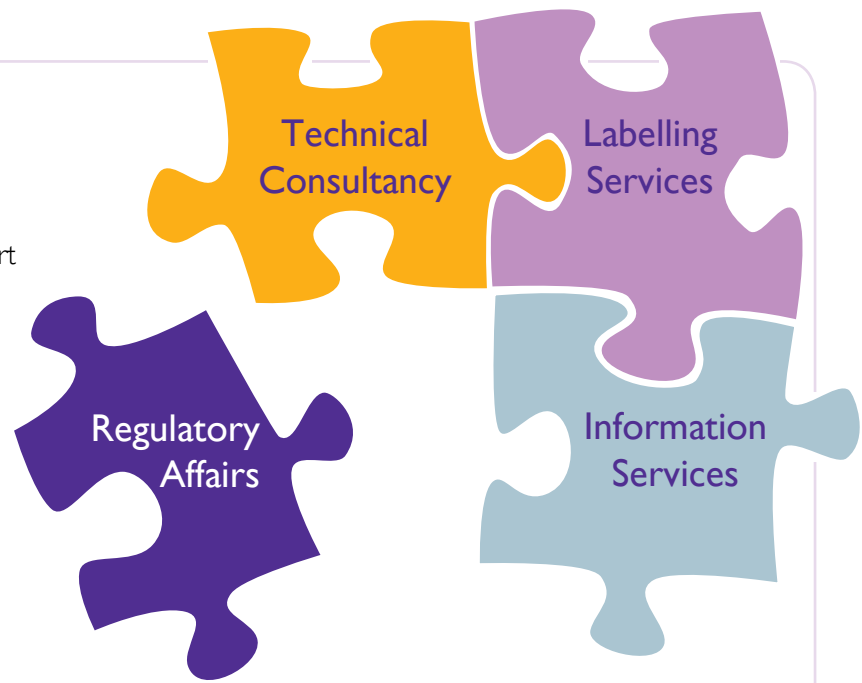

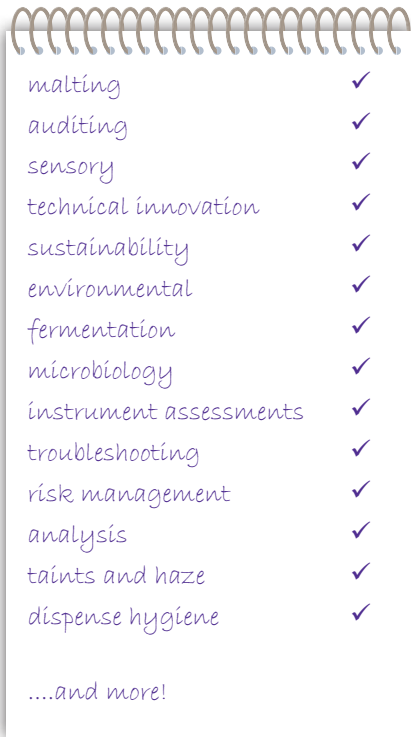
Beer Composition Database

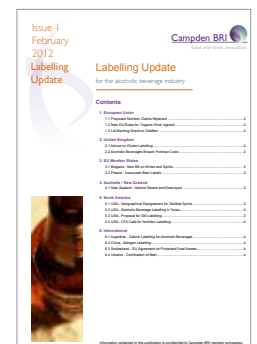
Labelling Update
